- M: How about these round ones with the checkered or flowery patterns? They are very popular.
- W: I'm afraid that those patterns are not my taste. Do you have a round one with stars on it?
- M: Yes, we do, but there's only one left.
- W: All right. I'll take it.

- M: Okay. I will.

W: Number Two

M: Can I use your computer? Mine is not working.

W: Sure. I have to use my computer.

W: Number Three

W: Is there anything wrong with it?

W: Number Four

M: I'm sorry I lost my room key.

W: Can I have your name and room number, please?

W: Number Five

M: Which do you prefer, coffee or tea?

W: I don't like either of them.
